Presidents Report 13 February 2018

The Satellite City BMX Club Management Committee is a collective group of people whom strive to achieve the best for members (and their families) of the Satellite City BMX Club. With a big year ahead, there is a lot on the 'plate' for the management committee. Cognisant of time spent during committee meetings, the Management Committee has decided to hold frequent meetings (monthly) until the season calms. The convening of regular meetings will allow for the management committee to track agenda action items to ensure decisions resulting in action items are achieved and the efficiency of productivity of the committee is sustained.

Since the last committee meeting, there has been some progress in the space of planning for the Round 3 of the National Series at Spanlift Stadium, we are obtaining quotes to have the berms bitumen and straights covered with sic surface (see www.sicsurface.com), we have secured a site at the Gateway Shopping Centre on 24 February so that members can renew their licences and potential members can join, we have locked in a local organisation to routinely assist with lawn maintenance at no cost to the Club, planning for our *Ride in2 BMX* day is well underway, the internet site has had a slight revamp and all content updated, and so much more. The Management Committee will keep our members abreast of what is happening through social media and the internet; these are the platforms which we will use to keep connected with our membership.

BMXNT are also actively pursuing coaching opportunities, the first of which will be in March 2018. Whenever coaching clinics are announced, we will be sure to share the information with you so that you can plan your days around coaching clinics☺.
